

## ALBANIA TOURIST VISA

- Foreign citizens who have a valid, multiple-entry Schengen visa, which has been previously used in one of the Schengen states, or foreign citizens who have a valid permit to stay in one of the Schengen states can enter Albania without a visa
- Foreign citizens who have a valid, multiple-entry US or UK visa, which has been previously used in the respective country of issuance, or have a valid permit of stay in the US or UK can enter Albania without a visa.
- If a visa application is required, then a personal interview may be necessary in Delhi if the applicant is a first-time traveler to Albania.

<b>Passports</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Original Passport with atleast 6 months validity and atleast 2 blank pages.</li> <li>* Original old passport booklets if any</li> </ul>
<b>Photographs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* 2 photographs each</li> <li>* White background; Glossy finish; 80% face coverage with a little shoulder to be seen; Eyes and face to be clearly visible; Dimensions: 45mm x 35mm</li> </ul>
<b>Visa Forms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Duly filled visa forms by the applicants (available on the links below) with signatures</li> <li>* Signatures for children (below 18 years) to have both parents's signatures along</li> </ul>
<b>Covering Letter</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* A covering letter per individual / family/ company addressed to The Visa officer,Embassy of Albania, New Delhi</li> <li>* The Covering Letter should brief the profile of the applicants and the purpose of travel with travel dates</li> <li>* Covering Letter can be on a plain paper for individuals and on the company letterhead for officials / sponsored applicants</li> </ul>
<b>Bank Statements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Original 3 months personal and company's bank statements with the seal and signature from the bank</li> <li>* Bank statements should be of relevant and active accounts which shows the proof of funds and income</li> <li>* Bank statements should be of a closing date closer to the date of visa application (A4 size preferred)</li> </ul>
<b>IT Returns</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Latest 3 years Income Tax Acknowledgement / ITR-V (Saral) of individuals and the company</li> </ul>
<b>Itinerary / Air tickets</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Return airtickets with all internal flight / train tickets if any</li> <li>* Day wise itinerary of the tour</li> </ul>
<b>Purpose of Travel / Accommodation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Any proof of your accommodation/ purpose at the destination/ Booking Certificate and payment receipts from the tour operator.</li> <li>* Notarized copy of the license of the Albanian travel agency, which invites the foreign tourist group</li> <li>* Hotel vouchers</li> </ul>
<b>Supporting Credentials</b>	<p><b>Businessmen:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Propreitership certificate / Certificate of Registration / Memorandum of Association, Articles of Association / PartnershipDeed / PAN Card</li> <li>* NOC from other partners or Directors incase of partnership</li> </ul> <p><b>Employees:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Leave sanction letter from the company (from the Government body incase of Government employees / public servants)</li> <li>* Last 3 months Salary Statements (only for Private firms)</li> <li>* Company ID card (optional)</li> <li>* Retirement Certificate or Letter / Copy of Pension Book (for retired employees)</li> <li>* Pension statements for the last three months;</li> </ul> <p><b>Students:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Leave sanction letter from the educational institution (for travel during working days)</li> <li>Bonafide Certificate from the educational institution (for travel during vacations)</li> <li>* School/ College ID card (optional)</li> </ul> <p><b>Newly Wed / Honeymooners (if the spouse's name is not endorsed in their passports):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Marriage Certificate (Original)</li> <li>* Wedding Invitation card / Photographs (incase the marriage certificate is not ready)</li> </ul> <p><b>Children travelling and unaccompanied by both the parents / either parent</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* A notary attested NOC on a stamp paper from both / either of the parent respectively if both/either of them unaccompany</li> </ul> <p>* Passport copies / copy of both / either of the parents</p>

	<p>*In case parents don't have passports , birth certificate of the applicant and copies of the ID cards of the parents.</p>
	<p><b>Travellers unaccompanied by spouses/partners</b></p>
	<p>* A notary attested NOC on a stamp paper from the unaccompaied spouse</p>
	<p>* Passport copy of the unaccompanied spouse. If not a passport holder, any Govt ID Proof mentioning spouse name can be submitted.</p>
	<p><b>Additional supporting documents if available</b></p>
	<p>* FD Receipts from banks</p>
	<p>* Public shares / debuntures certificate</p>
	<p>* Asset evaluation report from a CA</p>
	<p><b>* Physical Appearance of the applicant is must for the interview</b></p>
<b>Travel Insurance</b>	<p>* Valid Travel Insurance from the Embassy approved companies which covers the days of travel with minimum coverage of EUR 30,000</p>
