

## LEBANON BUSINESS VISA

Visa can either be applied in the Lebanese Immigration Department by support or sponsor in Lebanon. The Immigraion Approval will be translated from Arabic to English by the Lebanese Embassy, New Delhi and the applicant can travel on the translated Visa approval.

Visa can also be applied at the Lebanese Embassy, New Delhi who will refer the application to Lebanon for approval.

Documents	Particulars
<b>Passports</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Original Passport with atleast 6 months validity and atleast 2 blank pages.</li> <li>* Original old passport booklets if any</li> <li>*Colored Photocopy of the passport (identification pages).</li> </ul>
<b>Photographs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* 2 photographs each</li> <li>* White background; Glossy finish; 80% face coverage with a little shoulder to be seen; Eyes and face to be clearly visible; Dimensions: 45mm x 35mm</li> </ul>
<b>Visa Forms</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Duly filled visa forms by the applicants with signatures</li> <li>* Signatures for children (below 18 years) to have both parents's signatures along</li> </ul>
<b>Covering Letter</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* A covering letter per individual / family/ company addressed to The Consular Section, Embassy of Lebanon</li> <li>* The Covering Letter should brief the profile of the applicants and the purpose of travel with travel dates</li> <li>* Covering Letter can be on a plain paper for individuals and on the company letterhead for officials / sponsored applicants</li> </ul>
<b>Bank Statements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Original 3 months personal and company's bank statements with the seal and signature from the bank and minimum balance of 5 lakhs</li> <li>* Bank statements should be of relevant and active accounts which shows the proof of funds and income</li> <li>* Bank statements should be of a closing date closer to the date of visa application (A4 size preferred)</li> </ul>
<b>Supporting Documents</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*A covering letter from the organisation in India giving applicant's full details, duration of stay and purpose of visit and nature of expenses being covered.</li> <li>* A brief statement about the company in India and its products.</li> <li>* Letter from the Indian Chamber of Commerce</li> <li>*Copy of the Certificate of Incorporation of the Indian company issued by the Registrar of Companies of the concerned area</li> <li>*The letter of invitation from Lebanese company should be written in Arabic language with name of the person invited in English and the copy of invitation to be faxed directly in the Embassy on company letter-head, with full name, designation and company seal apart from signatures. This invitation letter should be addressed to the Consular Section, Embassy of Lebanon, New Delhi with a copy to the invitee. The invitation should be notarized. A copy should be kept along with the visa application.</li> <li>*A declaration on company's letter head stating that the company will take full legal, judicial &amp; financial responsibilities of the return of the person who is applying for the visa.</li> <li>*Hotel Booking or other accommodation proof in the name of the applicant</li> <li>*Return air tickets</li> </ul>
<b>Disclaimers</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* The above list of documents are the standard requirements for the visa application. The Embassy / Consulate/ High Commission/ Application Centres hold the rights to demand further documents for verification.</li> <li>* The Embassy / Consulate / High Commission hold the rights to call the applicant for a Personal Interview if needed</li> <li>* BPVS offers Visa Facilitation services to our customers against a Service Fee</li> <li>* BPVS at no stage guarantees the outcome of any visa application. The decisions on the Visa applications would be at the sole discretion of the respective Embassy/ Consulate / High Commission</li> </ul>
