

SOUTH KOREA VISA FOR SPORTS / ARTS / CULTURAL EVENTS

Documents	Particulars
Passports	* Original Passport with atleast 6 months validity and atleast 3blank pages. * Photocopy of the Bio Data Page of the Current Passport (First and Last Page) * Original old passport booklets if any
Photographs	* Two photographs taken within the last 6 months. (3.5cm X 5cm)
Visa Forms	*Duly filled application forms with signatures.
Covering Letter	* A covering letter per individual / family/ company addressed to The Visa officer, The Consulate General of the Republic of Korea * The Covering Letter should brief the profile of the applicants and the purpose of travel with travel dates. Covering letter should state the purpose of visit and day to day details * Covering Letter can be on a plain paper for individuals and on the company letterhead for officials / sponsored applicants
Itinerary / Air tickets	* Return airtickets. Applicants residing inside India must have a direct flight from India to Malaysia and direct return flight ticket from Malaysia to India
Purpose of Travel / Accommodation	* Hotel Vouchers or other accommodation proof. * Day wise itinerary of the trip * SPORTS/ART AND CULTURE: (IN CASE OF STUDENT, UNDER AGE OF 30 YEARS, FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS OF THEIR PARENTS WOULD SUFFICE.) - Invitation letter(Scan copy or Photocopy) - Business/Organization Registration Certificate - Achievement certificates - If Applicant is student than he/she can provide their bonafide certificate from collage or institute also. Else Occupation Proof OR Employment Certificate. (Specimen copy – click here) - 1 yr. Income tax return personal (Last Assessment Year) or (In absence of Income Tax Return please provide explanatory note with 6 months bank statement till the date of submission)
Supporting Credentials	Children travelling and unaccompanied by both the parents / either parent * A NOC from both of the parents mentioning whether they are accompanying or not accompanying on the travel. * Passport copies / copy of both / either of the parents *In case parents don't have passports , birth certificate of the applicant and copies of the ID cards of the parents. Travellers unaccompanied by spouses/partners * A NOC letter from the unaccompanied spouse * Passport copy of the unaccompanied spouse. If not a passport holder, any Govt ID Proof mentioning spouse name can be submitted.
